Notice to Penn Traffic Members:

In a near-unanimous vote last night at the Troy, PA Fire Hall, Local 1776's Penn Traffic members authorized the Local to meet with officials of Tops Markets, Inc., to negotiate changes in our collective bargaining agreement with Penn Traffic if, as expected, Tops emerges from the Penn Traffic bankruptcy proceedings as the successful bidder for Penn Traffic's stores.

Tops has indicated to Local 1776 its intention to keep open most of the stores in which our members work. Tops has requested to meet with us to negotiate changes to our collective bargaining agreement to keep these stores financially feasible and to save the jobs of most of the Penn Traffic members of UFCW Local 1776.

Any proposed changes will be presented to the members and subject to their ratification vote.
