CITY COUNCIL AT-LARGE

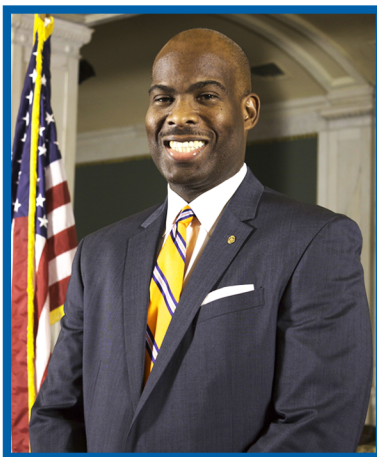

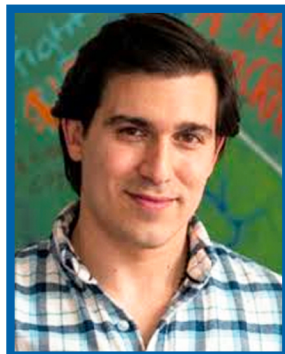
